The HANDS program has expanded into many counties, and now provides in-home services to not only first time parents, but also parents who have a newborn and other children.

What is the HANDS Program?

- A voluntary home visitation program for new and expectant parents.
- Families will receive information and learn about resources available in the community for new parents.
- Families may receive further support through home visitation.

Who Can Participate?

- First-time moms and/or dads residing in Kentucky.

When do HAND Services Begin?

- Services can begin during pregnancy or any time before a child is 3 months old.

WHAT'S NEW?

- HANDS EXPANSION – MULTIGRAVIDIA (in some counties)
- No longer for first-time families, this service is now available also for new or expectant parents who are parenting other children.
