

Did You Know?

Kentucky has 13 regional rape crisis centers across the state. All provide an array of services to victims of sexual violence including children, adult survivors of childhood sexual abuse, and family and friends of those who have experienced sexual violence. To access the statewide directory of rape crisis centers, go to www.kasap.org.

Most services provided by the rape crisis centers are FREE of charge. Available services include: 24 hour crisis phone line and crisis counseling; therapy services; medical and legal advocacy; awareness and prevention education and consultation.
